This article discusses how to control the printer font size in Great Plains.

MORE INFORMATION

Add printer setup options to the Dex.ini file to control the printer font size.

MinMilHeight=200

The MinMilHeight default value is 150 on Laser Printers.

- To shrink the font size, use a value less than 150.
- To expand the font size, use a value greater than 150.

The MinMilHeight has returned mixed results on HP printers. In some cases on HP printers, the MinMilHeight may not change the actual printer output. The MinMilHeight also can help if your printed text is overlapping.

Tolerance = 0

The Tolerance command will ignore the font defaults and force the system to use the font utilized in Great Plains.

Tolerance=-1

The Tolerance command will ignore the font defaults and force the system to use a true type font.

Tolerance=100

The Tolerance command will ignore the font defaults and force the system to use the default font set in Great Plains.
